
We are Back!

It is an "O" Scale (1/4"= 1 ft.) model railroad located in a 103' by 32' room with trains traveling over 4,000 feet of track, connecting two major cities, each with full yard and engine facilities. Canadian National and Canadian Pacific trains appear regularly on the Central Ontario Railway.


